## in the municipal elections on September 11



### We fight for:

- Secure jobs and collective agreements for all away with slave-like working conditions and racist division.
- Stop rent increases and food price hikes raise child benefits, income support and pensions.
- Welfare without private profit and welfare for ALL.
- All children have the right to good and equal education.
- Fight militarism and war. NO to Swedish membership of NATO.
- Fight against class inequality: let big business, banks and billionaires pay. For democratic socialism with public ownership of the big companies and democratic rule by the workers.

Rättvisepartiet Socialisterna (RS) is not like other parties. We organise struggles in the streets, neighbourhoods and workplaces:

- We are a driving force in the *No to Market Rent Network*. 200 protests last spring created the pressure that brought down the government and scrapped the market rent proposal, which would have meant 30-90% higher rents.
- In Luleå, several schools were saved from closure by a big protest movement involving thousands of parents and students. We have also pressured the city council to introduce better protective equipment against infection for elderly care workers.
- In Haninge, we have stopped the reduction of council workers' health care allowance, preschool budget cuts, saved leisure centres from closure and forests from being cut down.
- Across the country, we organise and participate in the fight against racism, war, sexism, environmental destruction (like mines), welfare cuts and injustices.

 We organise support for workers on strike, refugees fighting for asylum and international solidarity with trade unionists, women's campaigners, dissidents and political prisoners.

We are the only party whose candidates live on no more than a regular worker's wage, not accepting the privileges politicians receive.

We belong to the International Socialist Alternative, which has parties and groups in over 30 countries. We take part in the struggle against both Russia's invasion of Ukraine and the brutal wars led by the US and NATO.

We stand for the abolition of capitalism and imperialism – for democratic socialist planning according to the needs of people and the environment.

# Questions and answers on how to vote:

#### Who can vote?

Local/regional elections (municipal and regional councils):

Citizens from non EU-countries not in the EU who have been registered in Sweden for at least three years have the right to vote in local and regional elections. EU citizens registered in Sweden also have the right to vote in local and regional elections.

We urge everyone to vote for Rättvisepartiet Socialisterna in the municipal elections (white ballot paper) and Vänsterpartiet for the national parlament (yellow ballot paper) and the region (blue ballot paper).

#### What is a voting card and when will I receive it?

By 24 August, all voters should have received their voting card in their letterbox. If you have not received a voting card by 24 August, please contact your municipality or Länsstyrelsen.

#### Where can I vote?

From 24 August, you can vote in advance (see the municipality's website for early voting locations). On election day, 11 September, you can vote at the polling station indicated on your voting card.

#### **Postal voting:**

If you are unable to vote at an early voting location or polling station on election day, you can vote by mail. From 8 August, you can notify that you need to vote by post on val.se.

#### What do I need to vote?

Your voting card, identity document (passport, driving licence or ID card) and the ballot paper of the party you want to vote for. If you do not have an ID document, another person can certify your identity, but they will have to show an ID document.
